- ∞ How *Financial Peace University* (FPU) or *Financial Peace School Curriculum* (FPSC) will help your clients or students
- ∞ How many FPU or FPSC kits are you requesting
- ∞ How do you plan to continue funding the program when this grant ends

Also enclose the following:

- ∞ A copy of your organization's IRS determination letter
- ∞ A list of your organization's civic and business relationships
- ∞ A list of Board members, and their civic and business affiliations
- ∞ Your organization's current operating budget (please identify specified financial literacy dollars in the budget) and financial statements (reviewed or audited, if available)
- ∞ A list of the people responsible for implementing your organization's financial literacy project
- ∞ Your organization's strategic plan (if available)
